Approval of Provisional Certificates (PC) and Consolidated Grade Memos (CGM) for Eligible Students after Applying Grace Marks

Resolution: The Chairperson presented the details of the students who are eligible for the degree after adding grace marks in the Regular / Supplementary examinations conducted during December 2024 / January, 2025.

As per the affiliating university order dated 27.04.2024, with proceeding no: JNTUH/EB/R18 Grace Marks/3/2024 (Revised), the eligible students for degree are the regular students, admitted during the academic year 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 and lateral entry

students admitted during academic year 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23, after adding grace marks up to 0.50% (i.e., 30 marks for regular students and 23 marks for lateral entry students) for any number of theory subjects.
