- f. **Advanced Programming Laboratory** is introduced in VII semester
- g. **Comprehensive Examination** is introduced in VIII semester.

6. Panel of Examiners for question paper setting for the courses in I and II semester


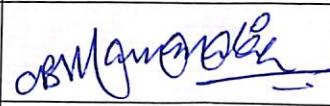

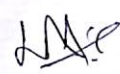

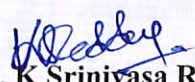
