


Figure 1: Program Outcomes (PO) Direct Attainment for MBA 2018 – 2020 batch




Figure 2: Program Outcomes (PO) Indirect Attainment for MBA 2018 – 2020 batch




Figure 3: Program Outcomes (PO) Overall Attainment for MBA 2018 – 2020 batch
