Agenda and Discussions

1. Review of Previous Meeting Action Taken Report

The committee reviewed the action taken on the recommendations of the previous meeting and discussed the status of awareness, grievance redressal and student-support activities.

2. Review of SC/ST/OBC Student Grievances

The committee reviewed the grievances received from students belonging to SC/ST/OBC categories. It was noted that grievances, if any, should be handled confidentially and resolved through the prescribed institutional mechanism.

3. Prevention of Caste-Based Discrimination

The committee reiterated the Institute's commitment to maintaining a campus free from caste-based discrimination and ensuring dignity and respect for every individual.

4. Awareness of Scholarship and Financial Support

The committee discussed dissemination of information regarding government scholarships, fee reimbursement and other financial-support schemes available to eligible students.

5. Academic Support and Counselling

The committee discussed providing academic guidance, mentoring and counselling support to students who require additional assistance to improve their academic performance.

6. Equal Opportunity and Inclusivity
