STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE

for

Conduction of Semester End Examinations and Skill Enhancement Project

01 February, 2024

I. PROGRAMMING COURSES (PRACTICAL)

- 1. The Semester End Examination (SEE) of all programming courses will be conducted at Career Development Centre (CDC).
- 2. Student(s) have an option to take two attempts to write the laboratory examination, out of which, best marks are taken and awarded.
- 3. For the programming related courses, it is mandatory for all the students to register for day slots (upto 2) from 06.00 AM to 07.30 PM at CDC.
- 4. After registering at CDC, students are required to sign in with their valid credentials by using IARE BuildIT platform.
- 5. The laboratory course handling faculty with supporting staff are required to be available in CDC as per examination schedule.
- 6. The external examiner shall be appointed by the Principal.
- 7. For evaluation of the programming laboratory, four senior faculty members are allotted.
- 8. The SEE is conducted for 3 hours for a total of 60 marks, that are bifurcated (Two programs for 50 marks and one additional program for 10 marks) as shown below:
 - (a) 10 marks for write-up
 - (b) 15 marks for experiment / program
 - (c) 15 marks for evaluation of results
 - (d) 10 marks for viva-voce on concerned laboratory course

(e) 10 marks for presentation on another experiment / program in the same laboratory course

- 9. Students have an option to write all the programs / are part of the program.
- 10. Students are required to present their experiment / program at specified venue as per SEE schedule.
- 11.Marks are awarded based on the performance in the laboratory, number of program(s) he/she has written and executed.
- 12. Students are recommended or advised to bring their own laptops.

II. SKILL ENHANCEMENT PROJECT

- 1. The Semester End Examination (SEE) of all skill enhancement project will be conducted at respective departments.
- 2. The course handling faculty with supporting staff are required to be available in respective laboratory as per the given SEE schedule.
- 3. The external examiner shall be appointed by the Principal.
- 4. For evaluation of the skill enhancement project, one / two senior faculty members are allotted.

- 5. The SEE is conducted for 3 hours for a total of 60 marks, are bifurcated as shown below:
 - a. 10 marks for presentation of the project
 - b. 20 marks for design / implementation
 - c. 20 marks for results and discussions
 - d. 10 marks for viva-voce on concerned skill enhancement project
- 6. Students are required to submit individually / group, skill enhancement project hardcopy to respective HODs.
- 7. Students are required to submit project in the form of both softcopy and hardcopy.
- 8. Students are required to present skill enhancement project at specified venue as per given SEE schedule.
- 9. Marks are awarded based on the performance in the SEE.
- 10. After evaluation, report should be uploaded into Samvidha (Campus Management Portal).
