



Feedback Analysis on Feel Safe and Secure



Figure 2 represents the survey on the alleys of the campus indicated 85.54% satisfied and 14.46% not satisfied responses. So overall, the response seems to be good.









Figure 3 depicts the survey on inside parking lots indicated 85.41% satisfied and 14.59% not satisfied responses. So overall response seems to be good.

Around campus






Figure 5 describes the survey on around campus indicated 85.18% satisfied and 14.82% not satisfied responses. So overall response seems to be good.

Inside the campus public transportation vehicles



How safe do you feel inside the campus







Conduction of Safety seminars







Self-defense classes
