

On the alleys of the campus



Inside parking lots



Inside campus buildings



Around campus



Inside the campus public transportation vehicles



How safe do you feel inside the campus



Availability of Security cameras





Emergency phone lines



Conduction of Safety seminars



Self-defence classes



Safety Advice for Women


