

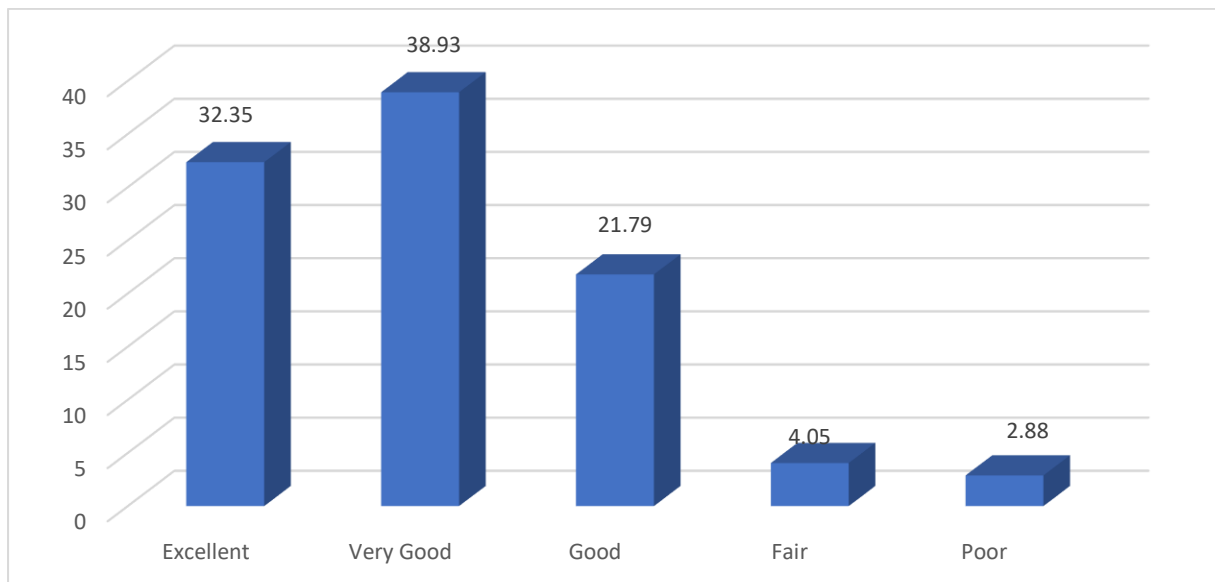

On the alleys of the campus

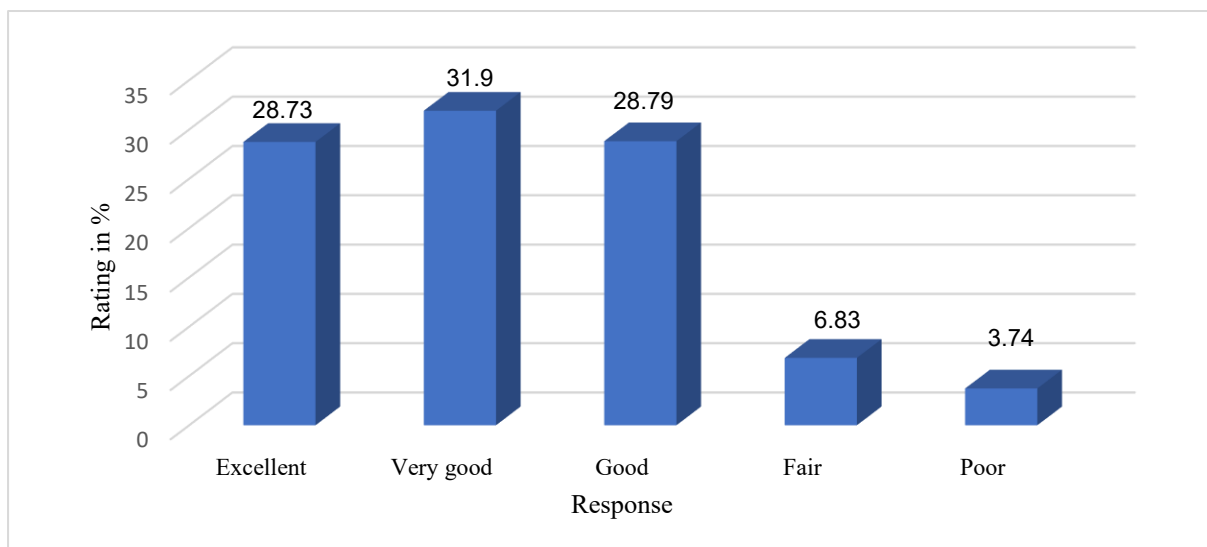

Inside parking lots

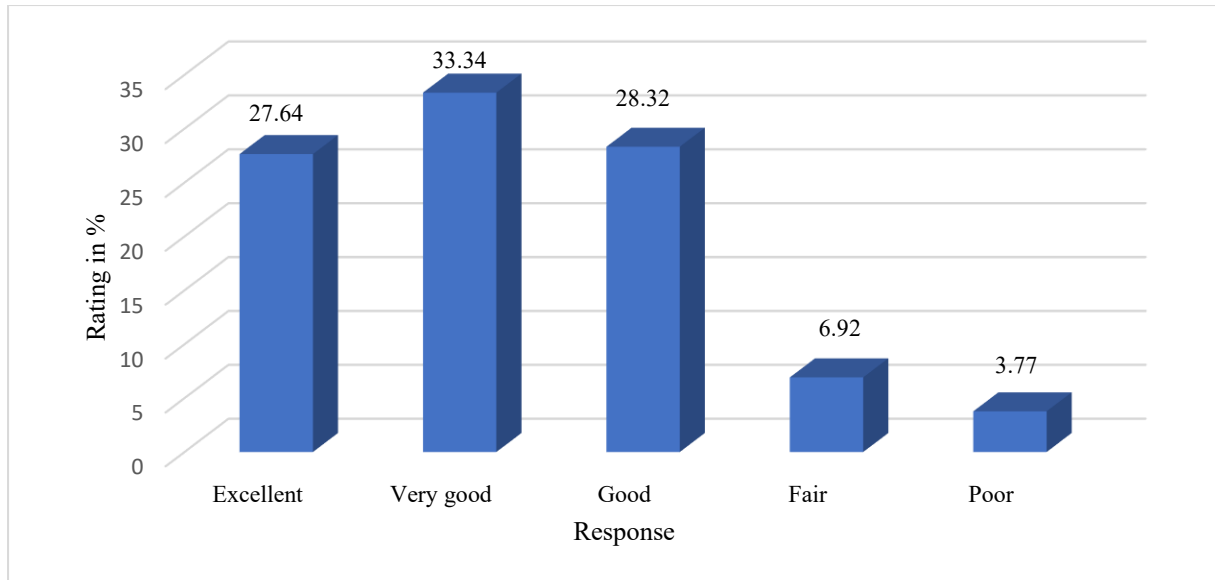

Around Campus

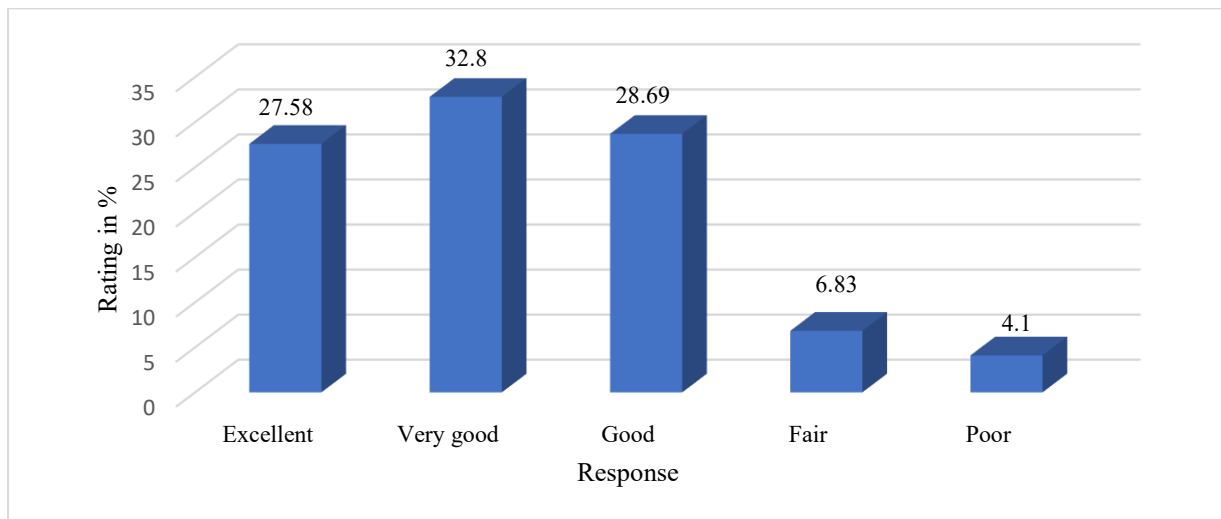

Inside the campus public transportation vehicles

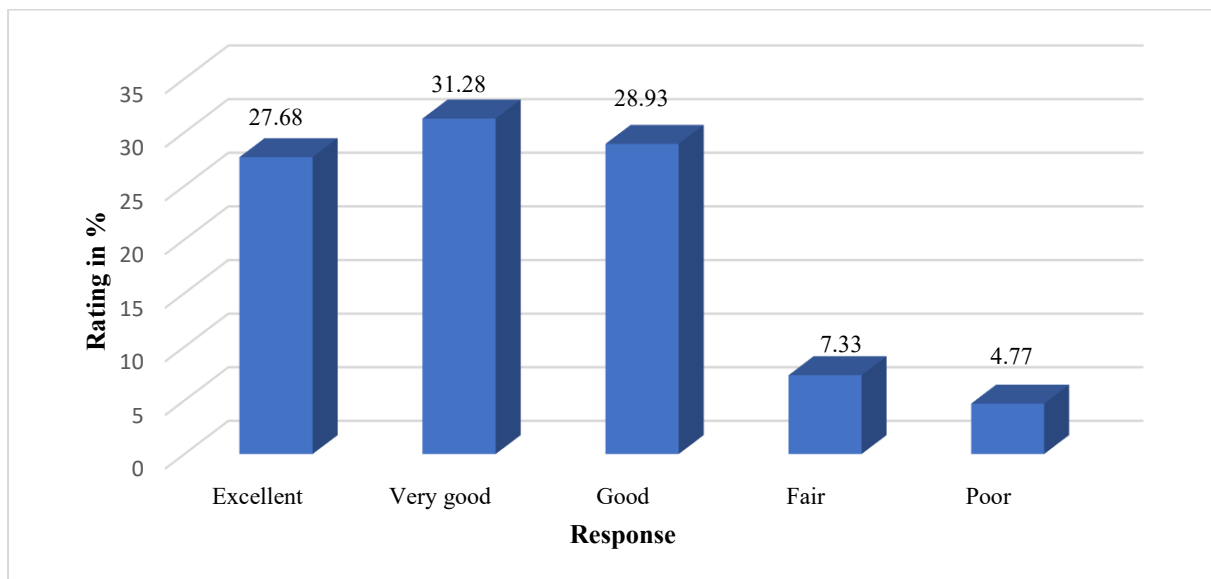

How safe do you feel inside the campus

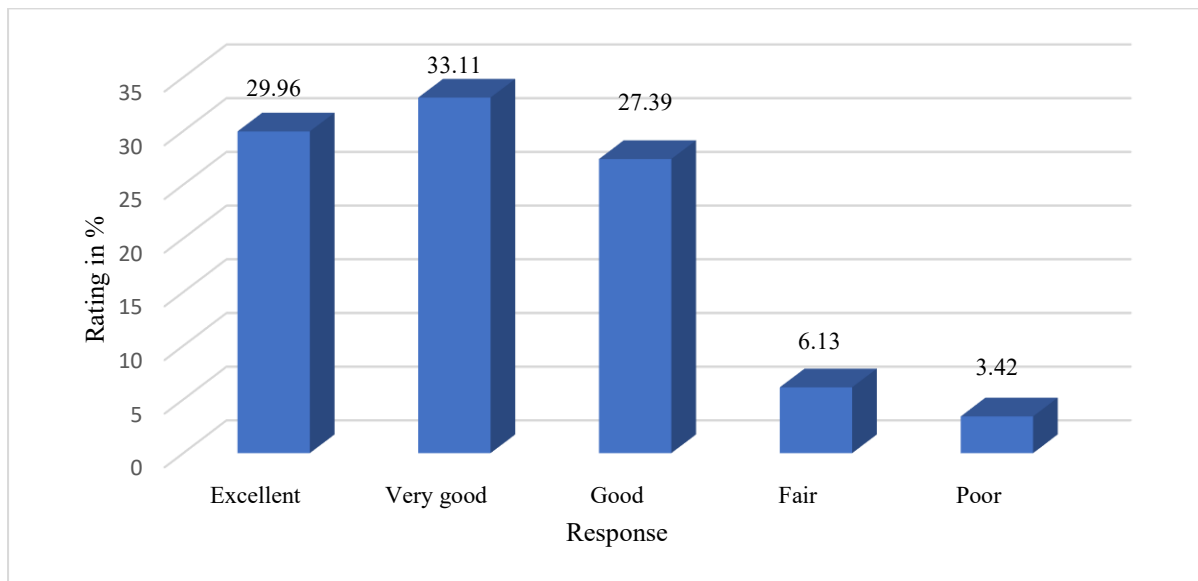

Availability of Security Cameras

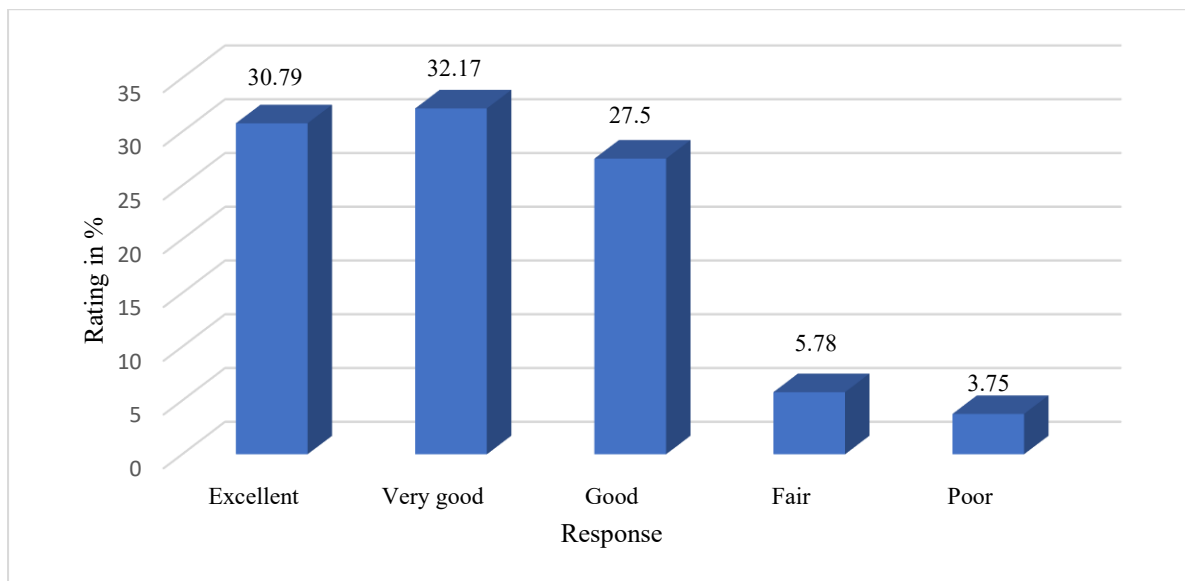

Security Guards

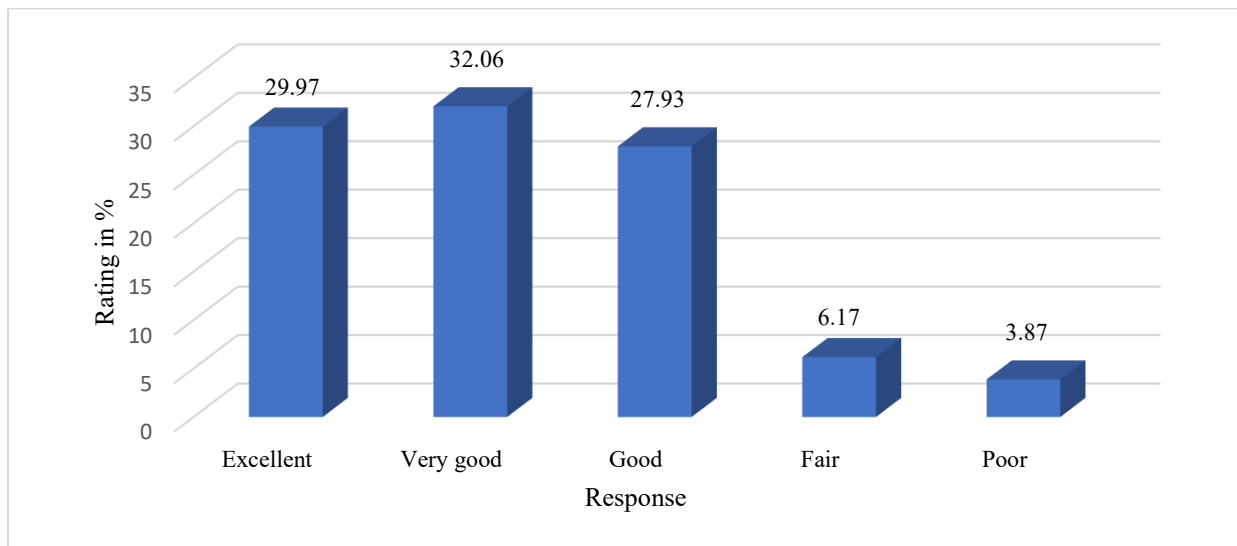

Emergency phone lines

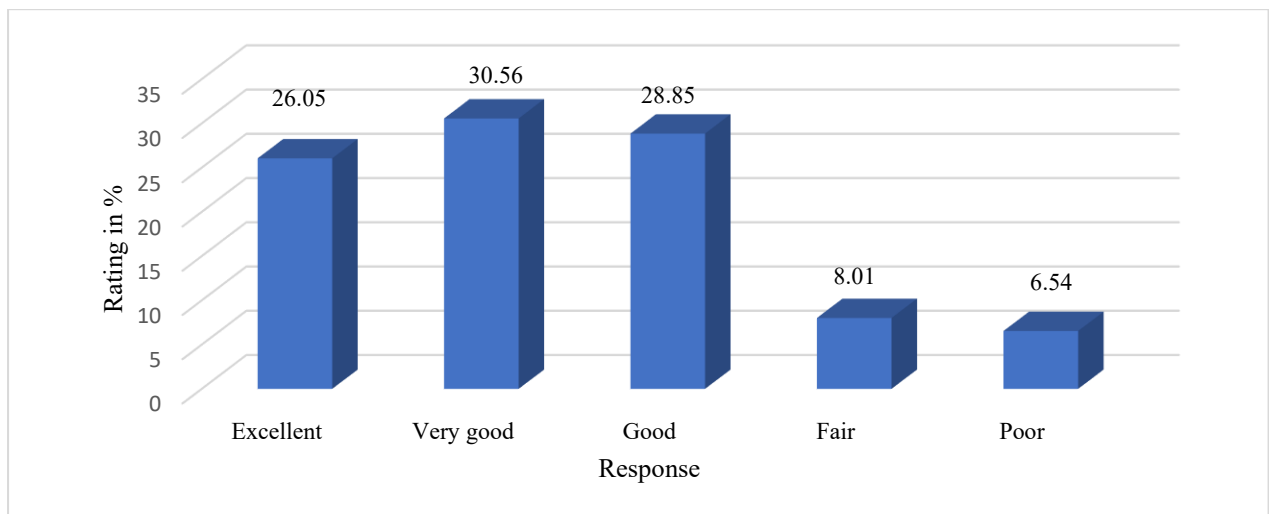

Conduction of Safety Seminars

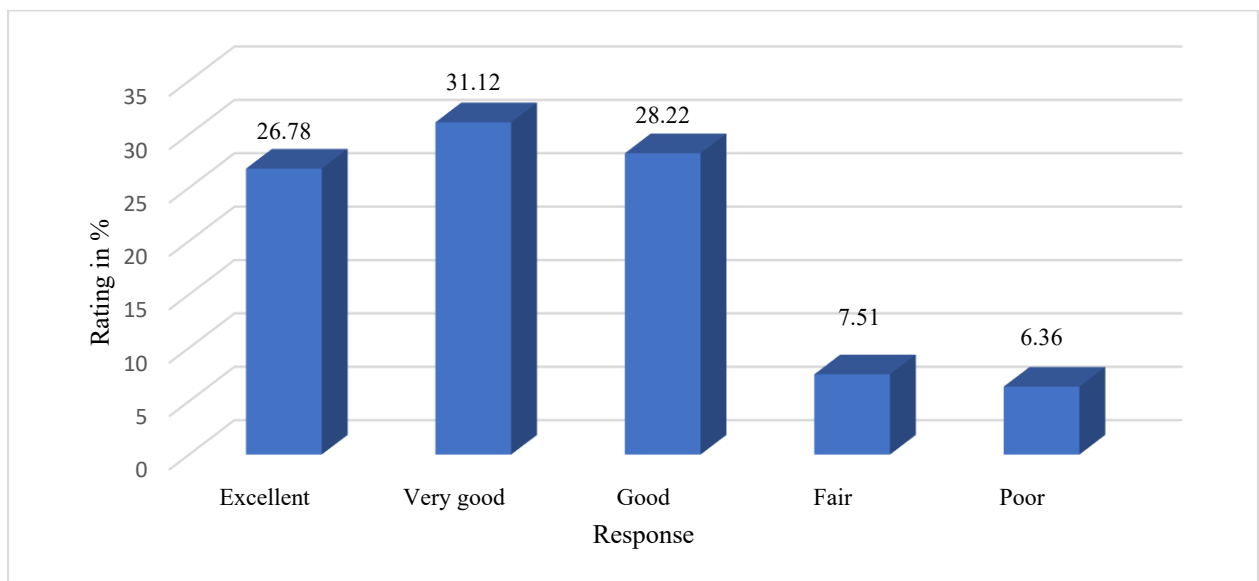

Self-defense classes

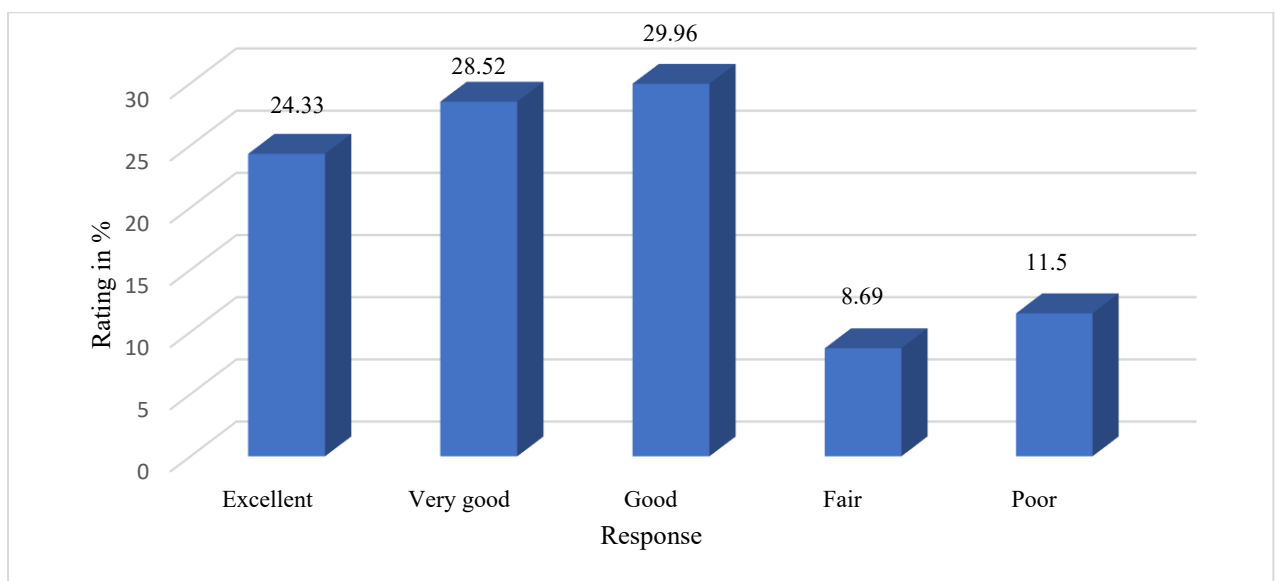

Safety Advice for women

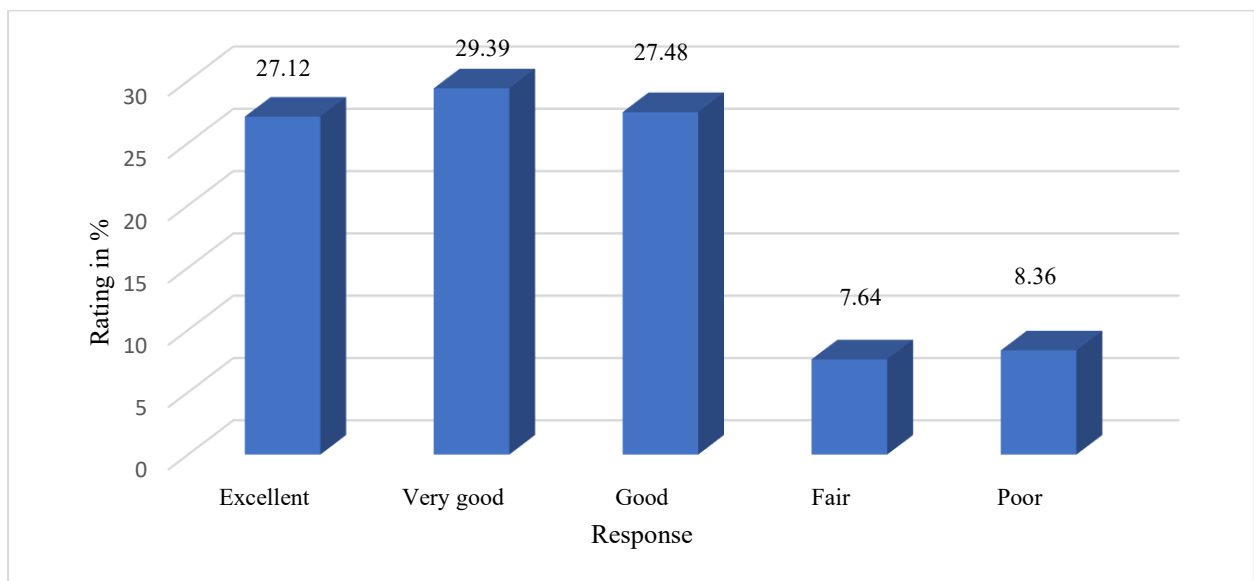
